After the Storm

Hirokazu Kore-eda's Latest Masterpiece Comes to the JCCC

Gentle and melancholy yet surprisingly amusing, the latest film by celebrated Japanese auteur Hirokazu Kore-eda (Our Little Sister, Like father Like Son) focuses on Ryota (Hiroshi Abe), a failed writer, third-rate detective, and no-luck gambler who has become separated from his wife and young son. When a typhoon strikes one night, the broken family is forced to spend the night together at the home of Ryota's mother, where the ensuing interaction — free of melodrama or forced catharsis — is tender, bittersweet, and quietly incisive, in true Kore-eda style. A bit hit at TIFF, this is one of the best films of 2016. Also starring Kirin Kiki, Yoko Maki and Satomi Kobayashi.

Heritage Corner

Since the end of November 2016, I have been working here at the Japanese Canadian Cultural Centre as the Archives Assistant. My position and the project I am working on were made possible by the Documentary Heritage Communities Program grant (DHCP) which the JCCC, in partnership with the Nikkei National Museum, was fortunate enough to receive this year. The DHCP strives to provide assistance in having Canada's histories and memories documented and made accessible to the community. Over the past four months, I have been conducting an inventory of all the documents, artefacts, and photographs that relate to Nikkei Veterans from World War I, World War II, and the Korean War that we have here in the Archives. I have been cataloguing items as I go as well as ensuring they are stored properly. Additionally, I've done quite a bit of research both in and outside of the archival material in order to create a small exhibition telling the stories of some Nikkei Veterans and finding the best artefacts and documents that will help to tell their stories.

Completing this project for the JCCC has been a fascinating experience. I have thoroughly enjoyed sorting through the archives and finding so many interesting treasures and memories. The most meaningful part of the job, however, has been being able to hear all the personal stories from the archive volunteers and other community members. It has been a wonderful opportunity to immerse myself in this history.

One of our long time volunteers, Toshie, has been working diligently for the past several months cataloguing the collection of photographs and documents belonging to Yosh Hyodo. Recently, she came across this photo, titled "Official Board, Vancouver Japanese United Church, 1941" (2014.26.06.97.26). This beautiful photograph shows a great level of detail and we would love to be able to identify more of the people in the photo.
