

# Japanese Canadian Survivors Health and Wellness Fund Grant - Honour our JC Survivors Day on Saturday August 20, 2022

The JCCC was approved for a grant from the Japanese Canadian Survivors Health and Wellness Fund (JCSHWF) in BC and will host an afternoon on Saturday August 20, 2022 between 1pm – 4pm for current and past JCCC members who are Japanese Canadian Survivors (Japanese Canadians who were uprooted and displaced during WWII including those families that left B.C. during the war and whose children were born out of province from 1942-1949).

This event will provide the opportunity to socialize and re-connect with other senior friends and members of our community, reminisce and share stories of their lives, view archival photos highlighting their pre-war life to post-war times, and take part in re-unions for those that were in internment camps. Refreshments and entertainment will be provided and guest speaker, Chris Hope will talk about his film Hatsumi (a documentary about his grandmother and her experience during the war).

The JCCC Heritage Department will be setting up displays and photos, and the latest exhibition titled Maru: Immigration Stories, an examination of the Japanese diaspora including Canada, will be open.

## **Somen Salad**

### **Ingredients**

2 bundles somen noodles

2 tsp vegetable oil

1 carrot, julienned

1/2 red pepper, julienned

1/4 cucumber, julienned

1 stalk celery, julienned

1 green onion, sliced

Dressing

1/2 cup vegetable oil

1/2 cup Japanese vinegar

1 tbsp shoyu (soy sauce)

1 tsp salt

1 tsp sesame oil

Chili flakes (optional)

### **Equipment**

Medium pot

Colander

Medium mixing bowl

Small mixing bowl

Whisk

Cutting board

Sharp vegetable knife

Measuring cups and spoons

Somen is a refreshingly cold noodle dish that is perfect for the summer heat. It is also a great summer dish when served as a salad!


## **Instructions**

- 1. Cook somen noodles in boiling water about 3 minutes.
- 2. Rinse well under running water then drain in a colander
- 3. In a medium mixing bowl, mix noodles with 2 tsp of vegetable oil. Allow to cool in refrigerator for at least 1 hour.
- 4. Combine all Dressing ingredients in a small mixing bowl and stir well with a whisk.
- 5. Julienne (cut thinly into matchstick sized pieces) all vegetables.
- 6. In a large bowl, toss chilled noodles and vegetables with dressing to taste.

## **Storage and Reheating**

Store any left over Somen Salad in the refrigerator. Left overs should be eaten or discarded within 3 days. The longer the salad sits, the more dressing it will soak up and noodles will become mushier.

## How long have you been a volunteer here at the JCCC?

My earliest recollection of volunteering at the Centre is helping Kay Shin wrapping china and other things bought at the Boutique at the Annual Bazaar. I have no idea how old I was or how I ended up helping at this particular booth.

#### 健やかな老後をめざして その53 - 巻き爪で苦しむあなたへ...

シニアに案外と多いのは足のトラブル(外反母趾や巻き爪)です。外反母 趾に関しては前号その52にて取りあげました。本号では巻き爪の対策を 考えてみましょう。「巻き爪とは爪の端が内側に巻き込んだ状態」です。巻き 込んだ爪の端が皮膚に当たる・刺さると痛みが生じます。ほとんどは足の親 指の爪に起こり、外反母趾と同様に女性に圧倒的に多いのです。女性は男 性に比べると関節が柔らかく、しかも筋力が弱いために、姿勢、歩行や靴な どによって足指に影響を受けやすいため、と考えられます。

巻き爪の痛みがあると歩き方や姿勢が悪くなり、膝・腰までも痛くなるこ とがあります。巻き爪の原因は、爪の切り方(深爪)、外反母趾による爪への 圧迫、足に合わない靴、指に力が入らないベタベタ歩き等です。骨は足の指 先まで届いておらず、骨のない部分を爪が支えています。爪は、起立や歩行 の際にあらゆる方向から圧を受けます。ですから、過剰の圧がかかる状態、 あるいは適度な圧がかからない状態が続くと、爪の正常な成長が妨げられ るのです。

足のアーチがくずれて足指が横に広がる等の変形、外反母趾、がに股 (つま先が外側を向いた歩き方)や内股(膝が内側に入った歩き方)が あると、爪に適切な圧がかかりにくくなります。歩き方に癖があると、過剰 な圧が親指にかかったり、親指が浮いたりして(浮き指)、自然と爪が巻 いていきます。

爪のケアのポイントは「頻繁に切らない(3~4週に1回)、長さは指 先より1mm程度、先端をまっすぐ切り、両角をやや丸く整える(スクエ アカット)、仕上げの保湿」です。私は、長時間歩くと爪周囲に痛みがあった のですが、10数年前にこれらの対策を始めてから徐々に改善しました。今思 えば、爪が隣の皮膚を押し気味だったのでしょう。

さて、靴の選び方も重要です。前号(外反母趾)で述べたように、合わな い靴によって様々な足のトラブルが生じるからです!「つま先に適度の余裕 がある靴、かかとが脱げにくく、甲をしっかりと固定できる靴、材質が柔らか く、かかとの高くない靴」を選びましょう。これらは、外反母趾が起こりにく い靴の条件と共通しています。ひも靴タイプであれば、しっかり甲を固定で きますね。

また、歩き方の癖は足のみでなく、膝、股関節や腰にも大きな影響を与え ます。人間が直立歩行を始めた原始時代からの健康課題ですが、足を使わ なくなった現代では非常に深刻になっています。また、コロナ禍で歩かなく なった生活も影響を与えています。つま先を正面に向けてまっすぐ足を出 し、かかとから着地し、足裏全体に重心をのせ、次にすべての指をしっかり 使って蹴り出せば、がに股、内股やベタベタ歩きは改善されます。

若い頃より良い姿勢に心がけていましたが、50代後半にハードな舞台 稽古で膝と股関節に問題が生じたことをきっかけに、正しい歩き方につい て更に意識するようになりました。上記に述べた望ましい歩き方に加えて、 歩幅をやや大きく踏み出して歩きます。テレビを観ながら、足指や足首のス トレッチやマッサージも行っています。筋肉や関節を柔らかく保つことも大 切です。

セルフケアで痛みや炎症が改善しなければ、爪の形を矯正する治療 (テーピング法、クリップ法、ワイヤー法など)を行う皮膚科・形成外 科・整形外科などの専門医に相談してみましょう。


